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Abstract

This study was conducted with the participation of the students in the English Department at the University of Sebha, Libya. This study aims at exploring the difficulties that face Libyan EFL learners in use of oral communication and teaching methods to teaching speaking skill. A total of 48 participants from 6th semester students participated in the study. Also, 3 teachers were targeted. Qualitative method was adopted to collect data. The findings of the study reveal some problems when speaking English by the learners in the Sebha University, Faculty of Arts such as lack of adequate exposure to English, psychological barriers, and vocabulary uses.

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
